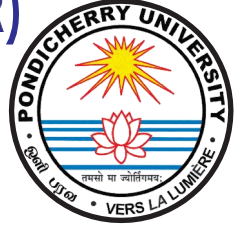

- **DATE, TIME AND DURATION:**
 - All students admitted to the first semester of MBA Finance are expected to be present on **Sunday, 22nd September 2024, from 9:15 AM to 1:00 PM.**
 - All students admitted to the first semester of MBA in HR, IB, General, Marketing, Operations, and Supply Chain Management specializations are expected to be present on **Sunday, 29th September 2024, from 9:15 AM to 1:00 PM.**
- **DRESS CODE and THEME:** Formals with shades of Blue
 - **MEN:** Sky blue Shirt and Black Pant with Shoes
 - **WOMEN:** Sky Blue Saree or Sky-blue Shirt with Black Pant or Sky-blue Tops with Salwar
- **TRANSPORTATION & VEHICLE PARKING:** Students are strictly prohibited from bringing four-wheelers onto campus. If necessary, they must park outside the campus at their own risk. Public transport is strongly recommended. Parking facilities are available at St. Joseph's PU College Main Entrance, St. Joseph's College of Law, and St. Joseph's Boys' High School.
- **DECORUM AND ETIQUETTE:** Students are expected to adhere to formal attire and follow the specified theme. You are expected to demonstrate professionalism in all forms of communication. Accompanying outsiders is strictly prohibited.
